2010 Annual Board of Directors Meeting Held January 9, 2010

The 22nd Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference Annual Board of Directors Meeting was held in Papillion on January 9, 2010. The following is a brief summary of the actions taken by the Board During the Meeting.

- Season scheduled to begin with Divisional Shoots on March 13, 2010
- Divisional Shoot Fees will remain \$20.00 for Seniors and \$10.00 for Juniors
- Conference Rule 14 was modified to allow provisions for teams comprised of Scout Troop members to participate in the Conference provided they do not attend a school with a trap team. Refer to Conference Rules for additional information.
- The Board has approved the implementation of a pilot test program during the 2010 season that will allow some teams to shoot outside of their division during the season on a voluntary basis. Additional information regarding this action will be e-mailed to the coaches prior to the start of the season.

2009 Coaches of the Year Named

In 2009, the Board of Directors established a Coach of the Year (COTY) Award to be awarded annually to one Junior Division and one Senior Division Head Coach. Selection criteria information is available on the web site. The 2009 Coaches of the Year were named at the end of the 2009 season. Congratulations to Tom Knutson of Louisville as the Junior Division Coach of the Year and Ardith Svitak of Stanton County 4-H as the Senior Division recipient.
