



2010 GAYLE HANSHAW ALL-CONFERENCE SHOOT RULES

1. Only shooters with an ECTC current season average who are eligible for All-Conference awards are eligible to shoot during this event.
2. Coaches are required to pre-register ELIGIBLE shooters that will be participating in this shoot during the week prior to the shoot as follows:
 - a. The Conference will post a list of eligible shooters by team on the ECTC website on the next day following the last day of the Conference Shoots. The Conference Statistician, Chuck Kopocis will accept all registrations from the coaches which are due on the Tuesday prior to the shoot by 10:00 PM. Registration via e-mail to ckopocis@cox.net is preferred. Squad assignments will be posted on the ECTC website by Thursday during the week prior to the All-Conference Shoot.
3. The 2010 All-Conference Shoot will be held on April 24, 2010 at Lincoln Trap & Skeet. Juniors will start shooting at 7:30 AM with the Seniors starting at 9:30 AM. The All-Conference Awards Ceremony is scheduled for approximately 10:00 AM for the juniors and 4:00 PM for the seniors.
4. All eligible shooters will be classified based on their ECTC Season Average with an equally divided number of shooters in each class:
 - a. JUNIOR DIVISION (grades 6-8) – 8 Classes – Class A1,A2,B1,B2,C1,C2,D1 and D2
 - b. SENIOR DIVISION (grades 9-12) – 16 Classes – Class A1 through D4
5. Each Division will consist of one (1) event each:
 - a. JUNIOR DIVISION (grades 6-8) – 25 sixteen yardage targets
 - b. SENIOR DIVISION (grades 9-12) – 50 handicap yardage targets – yardage determined by class as follows:
 - i. Class A1 & A2 – 25 yards
 - ii. Class A3 & A4 – 24 yards
 - iii. Class B1 & B2 – 23 yards
 - iv. Class B3 & B4 – 22 yards
 - v. Class C1 & C2 – 21 yards
 - vi. Class C3 & C4 – 20 yards
 - vii. Class D1 & D2 – 19 yards
 - viii. Class D3 & D4 – 18 yards
6. The cost of the 2010 All-Conference Shoot shall be \$5.00 for Juniors and \$10.00 for Seniors.
7. All awards for this shoot will be Individual awards which will be provided for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place in each of the classes. Awards for the All-Conference Shoot will be provided by the Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference.
8. In the event of ties, shoot-offs will determine placement in each of the classes.
9. Scoreboards must be kept in plain sight of the shooter and coaches.

10. Cash Awards may not be made directly to shooters.
11. Eye and ear protection are required to be worn by all shooters while shooting at Conference shoots. Any shooter observed not wearing eye and/or ear protection will be informed to get eye and/or ear protection or be removed from competition until eye and/or protection is secured.
12. The use of Drugs, alcohol and/or tobacco products by students at Conference shoots is prohibited.
13. The use of toe tabs for resting of muzzles is not permitted by the Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference during sanctioned competitions. Participants shall not rest muzzles on the top of their foot or any other part of their body at anytime.
